>TERRITORIAL COHESION SHOULD ENHANCE DIFFERENTIATION<

- physical aspects of territories
- the connected region
- distinction between physical aspects and socioeconomic aspects.
 - Cohesion between large land-uses (nature, agriculture) and rivers
 - Cohesion in functional system by large infrastructures
 - Cohesion between social and economic aspects via the pattern of settlements
- balanced way in which its geophysical, infrastructural and urban patterns are connected
- strategic regional planning should aim at differentiation
- economic innovation is supported by endogenous qualities
